Dear City Mosaic Participants and Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to the 15th City Mosaic! To ensure that you'll have a safe and fun event, please read all below information carefully.

THINGS TO DO BEFORE THE RACE

1. **Sign the Liability Waiver.** Participants under 18 years must have parents/guardians to sign the "City Mosaic 2019 Liability Waiver" in order to join the race.
2. **Make sure your contact information is accurate.** Each participant must provide the most updated email, contact phone # and emergency contact.
3. **Find a replacement member.** If a team member is unable to attend the race for any reason, please find a replacement and inform Across U-hub immediately by Wednesday, May 22. Otherwise, 100 points per member will be deducted for any absent member at check-in.

| Checkpoint Helper | Wearing blue City Mosaic Volunteer T-shirts and can be found within the boundaries of each checkpoint between 10:30 am and 3:45 pm. They will facilitate tasks, and verify answers for photo/video questions at the respective checkpoint and "Anywhere Challenge" questions. |

STAMPS

3 stamps to be obtained from the checkpoint helpers at EACH checkpoint station:

| Checkpoint Stamp | MUST be obtained to get the answers validated for that specific checkpoint. All members must be present to receive the stamp. |
| Photo/Video/Task Stamp    | Obtained when the correct photo/video/task is completed and presented to the respective checkpoint helper. |
| Anywhere Stamp | Obtained at ANY checkpoint station after the Anywhere Photo/Video/Task has been completed. |

- Expect line ups at the checkpoint station(s) for tasks and stamps. Line ups are part of the game and also part of our lives!

| Checkpoint D | 250 | Correctly answer all questions and complete all photos/videos/tasks at Checkpoint D. |
| Anywhere Challenge | 100 | Successful completion of all anywhere challenges. |
| Total Points | 1050 | Correctly answer ALL questions and complete ALL photos/videos/tasks. |
| Deductions | 200 | Arriving AFTER the completion time, but within the grace period. |
| | 100 per member | For any absent/missing member(s) at check-in, checkpoint station, and finishing line. |
| | 50 per member | Not wearing the City Mosaic T-shirt during the race. |
| Disqualification | | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any acts of misconduct, including any team engaged in verbal or physical aggression towards the public, fellow participants, or City Mosaic staff. Any team arriving AFTER the grace period. Refusal/failure to return the answer booklet. |

- Please write your answers CLEARLY. No part marks will be rewarded.
- Across U-hub Staff, The Race Referee, and City Mosaic Committee Members reserve the right to make the final decision on team scores and to disqualify any team or team members found to be violating the rules and regulations of the race.

- Finishing line opens at 3:30 pm. All team members MUST cross the finish line at Mel Lastman Square (North York Civic Centre) and submit the answer booklet TOGETHER to be considered as officially completing their race.

GUIDELINES AND REMINDERS

- All participants must check-in, start-off, and return to Mel Lastman Square (North York Civic Centre) at the designated time.
- Subway closures** may occur at **some** TTC stations on race day. Be prepared to find alternative routes.
- Please download a **STEP COUNTER** or **STEP TRACKER APP** to track your walking distance and steps.
- The race will continue, rain or shine.
- Race Referee Contact Number: 647-966-1944**
 - Will handle challenges, disputes, and discrepancies, and make the final judgment call for any disputes.
 - Will **NOT** give any clues or answers.
 - Call 911** and report to the Race Referee in any emergency situations.
 - Teams who fail to return for any reasons must notify the Race Referee before 4:30 pm.
- Transportation:** TTC or travel by foot only. Following traffic rules during the race is necessary.
- Electronic Devices:** To fully experience and enjoy the city first-hand, avoid using the Internet for answers.
- Pace your team for breaks and meals. Drink a lot of water to avoid dehydration.
- Every participant is responsible for his/her involvement in the race. Across U-hub, its sponsors, and partners are not liable for any sickness, personal injury, death, personal property loss/damage or any damage of public facilities that may directly or indirectly result from participation in the race.
